



The Wychwood Brewery is tucked away behind the main street of the market town of Witney, on the border of the Oxfordshire Cotswolds.

The brewery was founded in 1983 by Paddy Glenny and christened The Eagle Brewery. Chris Moss joined Paddy and in 1990, the Eagle was re-named the Wychwood Brewery after the ancient medieval Wychwood Forest which borders Witney.

Paddy sold his shareholding in 1990 to Ian Rogers. Aged only 27, Ian sold his house to become a partner with Chris and set about creating a chain of 40 real ale pubs intrinsically tied to the newly renamed Wychwood Brewery with all its myths and legends imagery.

Purchased by Marstons PLC in 2008 Hobgoblin has become one of the fastest growing premium beer brands in the UK. The brewery now hand crafts circa 52,000 barrels a year, including the Legendary Hobgoblin beer, a supporting range of imaginatively named bottled beers, and a calendar of limited edition seasonal cask ales.
